Conflict Minerals Policy

Itron (U.K.) Limited makes every effort to comply with the laws and regulations of the countries and regions where we operate, including the requirements of the following laws and regulations while conducting business based on highly ethical standards.

- 1) The requirement to prevent the importation of prohibited Russian iron and steel and products derived from such iron and steel (EU Regulation R.833/2014 as amended on 23 June 2023 and UK Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 as amended in 2023).
- 2) The requirement to prevent the importation of goods mined, produced, or manufactured wholly or in part with Uyghur forced labour, and to make a good faith effort to determine this to be the case (the US Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act 2021 / DFAR 252.225-7059).
- 3) The requirement to prevent the importation of conflict minerals including tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold mined in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (The US Dodd–Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act).

We will continue to work with our suppliers to carry out procurement activities that consider the impact of the use of raw materials that can cause social problems such as human rights violations, poverty, and environmental destruction.
